Bidders:

- 4. "Buy" bids and bids below the minimum bid level will not be accepted.
- 5. All bidding will be in US Dollars.
- 6. Lots failing to draw a bid will be returned to the consignor.
- 7. Payment for auction lots will be by checks drawn on a USA bank, International Money Order or via PayPal (3% fee added).
- 8. All winning bidders will receive an invoice with the lot numbers won, the total amount of the winning bids, and shipping and insurance charges, if applicable. Lots will be forwarded to the winner upon payment of the invoice, which must be paid within 10 days of receipt.
- The auction manager will determine the shipping and insurance charges for each winner, and will endeavor to send the lots by the most secure and least expensive option.
